INSTITUTIONAL REPORTING ON EMERGENCY FINANCIAL AID GRANTS TO STUDENTS FOR THE HIGHER EDUCATION EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND II as AUTHORIZED by THE CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE and RELIEF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS and RELIEF ACT 2021 CRRSAA PUBLIC LAW 116-260.

On December 27, 2020, the President signed into law the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) (Pub. L. 116-260). This new law makes available approximately \$22.7 billion for institutions of higher education under the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF), with funding devoted to programs previously authorized under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES) Act (Pub. L. 116-136), as well as funding for certain programs newly authorized under CRRSAA.

The following information is reported for the period, (4/1/2021-6/30/2021)

- I. This statement shall serve to acknowledge that our institution signed and returned to the US Department of Education the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- II. The total amount of funds that the institution has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA is \$182,918
- III. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the programs as of June 30,2021 is \$182,918
- IV. The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA programs are 163.
- V. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the CRRSAA programs are 163
- VI. The method used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under the CRRSAA programs is.

The total amount of grant funds received is \$ 182,918. A total of 100% of the funds received will be divided equally among all currently eligible enrolled students.

The students were provided "Request for Emergency Grant Funds Survey Form", requesting them to provide information to the institution regarding the coronavirus related expenses they have incurred. This information was used for emergency grants to be fairly and compliantly awarded.
